WEEK FIVE 7 NOVEMBER – 13 NOVEMBER 2011

Works associated with the temporary overlay for the Sydney Telstra 500 continue.

Works will continue along Australia Avenue. Traffic management will be in place between Herb Elliott Avenue and Grand Parade allowing the traffic to be contra flowed on the eastern carriage way.

New works will see:

- Concrete barriers will be placed along Dawn Fraser Ave; and
- Grandstands and Corporate structures being constructed along Dawn Fraser Ave, Kevin Coombes Ave and Australia Ave (Pit lane); and
- Painting of concrete barriers will begin; and
- The installation of demarcation fencing behind concrete barriers will begin.

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

- Monday 7th and Tuesday 8th November – Dawn Fraser Ave between Edwin Flack Ave and Olympic Blvd; and
- Wednesday 9th November– Dawn Fraser Avenue between Olympic Blvd and the entrance to the rail station.

WEEK SIX 14 – 20 NOVEMBER 2011

New Works will see:

- Concrete barriers will be installed along Murray Rose Ave and Showground Rd; and
- Grandstands and corporate structures being constructed in Dawn Fraser Ave and Edwin Flack Ave.

Special Note: Week 6 works a subject to change. Confirmation of these works will be issued next week.

During the each week, there may be the need for additional traffic diversions to be in place throughout the precinct. At all times traffic management wardens will be in place to ensure the smooth passage of traffic.
