AVENUE OF THE AMERICAS - PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN REFUGE

ISLANDS AND ASSOCIATED 'NO STOPPING' RESTRICTIONS

Following concerns raised by Newington residents and Newington Community Representatives regarding the need for a pedestrian crossing in the Avenue of the Americas adjacent to the medical centre and the bank, Council has investigated the matter and proposes to install pedestrian refuge islands at this location. The existing marked pedestrian crossing located south of Avenue of Europe was installed during the Sydney Olympics in 2000 and is located a fair distance away from the medical centre and the bank. Consequently, people are crossing the road at several locations and creating safety hazards.

Based on preliminary pedestrian and vehicle counts undertaken by Council, this location does not satisfy the numerical warrants for a marked pedestrian crossing. Therefore, to provide a safe crossing facility for pedestrians, it is proposed to install pedestrian refuge islands in the Avenue of the Americas adjacent to the medical centre and the bank.

To accommodate this facility it is mandatory to provide "No Stopping" restrictions on both approach and departure sides of the refuge islands resulting in a loss of four (4) indented parking spaces on the western side of the Avenue of the Americas adjacent to the medical centre and the bank.

The attached plan details the proposed pedestrian refuge islands and associated parking restrictions in Avenue of the Americas.

It is Council's practice for residents/businesses to be consulted prior to the introduction of any traffic scheme in local streets.

Your views on the impact of the proposed 'pedestrian refuge islands' and the removal of four (4) parking spaces on the western side of Avenue of the Americas and whether you agree with this proposal are invited. A pre-paid response form is attached for you to express your view. Please send your response by mail or fax (Fax No. 02-9643 1120) by Friday, 24 August 2012.
