### Re: Precinct Operations, 2010 Royal Easter Show

Sydney Olympic Park is currently preparing to host the 2010 Royal Easter Show. As in previous years the Authority is required to modify its precinct operations in order that the one million visitors to the Show have an enjoyable event experience, whilst maintaining efficient operations for the businesses in the Sydney Olympic Park precinct. As a business operator within the precinct, the Authority would like to make you aware of certain changes occurring in precinct operations during the period of the Show.

The changes in precinct operations mainly affect traffic conditions around the site. Please be advised that Australia Avenue will be closed on Thursday 18th March 2010, between Murray Rose Avenue and Kevin Coombs Avenue. This closure forms part of the licensed area for the Show and will continue through until Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2010. During the public opening days of the Show (Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> April), there will be a number of other road closures and changes to the traffic conditions. All details of the changes to traffic conditions are listed in the attachment to this letter.

A key resource in coordinating major events at Sydney Olympic Park is the Sydney Olympic Park Operations Centre. The Operations Centre is manned every hour of the Show and can respond to nearly all incidents as they arise. If, at any time, you feel that an issue associated with the Show is affecting your business, please contact the Operations Centre and ask for the Events Manager. ## ATTACHMENT: PRECINCT OPERATIONS 2010 ROYAL EASTER SHOW

The following closures will affect the listed roads within Sydney Olympic Park Precinct from Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> March to Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2010.

- Australia Avenue: Between Murray Rose Avenue and Kevin Coombs Avenue
- Showground Road : Between Murray Rose Avenue and Grand Parade
- Grand Parade: Between Olympic Boulevard and Australia Avenue
- Olympic Boulevard: Between Dawn Fraser Avenue and Kevin Coombs Avenue

During show operations, that is Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> April the following roads will operate as restricted access, approved vehicles only.

Kevin Coombs Ave: Between Pondage Link and Australia Ave, No left turn from Pondage Link into Kevin Coombs Ave

Marjorie Jackson Parkway: Between Australia Ave and Bennelong Rd

Olympic Boulevard: Between Kevin Coombs Ave and Sarah Durack Ave

Dawn Fraser Ave (west) will operate as a Cul-de-Sac. Dawn Fraser (west) will primarily be used as a Show Patron and Worker drop off and pick up. Access only from Edwin Flack Ave

Herb Elliott Ave will be closed at Olympic Boulevard

Figtree Drive will be closed at Olympic Boulevard

Murray Rose Avenue, Restricted Access

Park Street between Dawn Fraser Ave and Murray Rose Ave, Restricted Access

# Vehicle access to Sydney Olympic Park Venues during the RES period will be as follows;

Australia Centre: Access via southern Australia Ave only.

Sports Centre: No Change

Aquatic Centre: Access to P2 via Edwin Flack Ave only

Athletics Centre: Access to P2 via Edwin Flack Ave only.

ANZ Stadium: Access to P1 via Edwin Flack and/or Hill Rd. Access to Loading dock, no change

Acer Arena: Access to 1 via Edwin Flack and/or Hill Rd. Access to loading dock, Edwin Flack Ave, via Pondage Link or Old Hill Link.

Pullman, Ibis and Novotel Hotels: Herb Elliott Avenue only

## During show operations the following transport services will be provided;

Major Event Bus Services. Services will operate on all the major event routes. Routes include; Warriewood, Macquarie, Glebe, Maroubra, Miranda, Cronulla, Menai, Rouse Hill, Dural and Castle Hill

City Rail services will be provided to and from Olympic Park Station throughout the duration of the show.

For detailed transport it is recommended that staff contact the Transport Information Line on 131 500.

A Taxi Rank will be operational on Herb Elliott Avenue during show operations from 15:00 to 23:00.

For the duration of the show the route services 401, 450, 525 and 533 bus stop at the rear of the railway station has been relocated to Australia Avenue near Herb Elliott Avenue adjacent to the front of the Station.

#### Check Points associated with the Show Operations include;

Park Street, North side of Dawn Fraser Avenue- To operate each day of the show to redirect Show patrons. All vehicles needing to access gate 15 will be given access on production of a valid permit. There will be unrestricted access to Parkview Drive and Herb Elliott Avenue.

### Sydney Olympic Park Authority managed carparks:

Employees who normally park in the P6 series of car parks who are unable to find a parking space, may park in the P3 car park, which is located on Sarah Durack Avenue (permit holders must display their valid SOPA parking permit).
